Volunteer Drivers needed to transport patients from a designated pickup location to the facility by way of DAV vans stationed in the community. All potential drivers must meet safety and health requirements.

- **Parking Lot Shuttle** – transport patients from parking lot to main entrance, position available:
 - 8a-12n Friday
 - 12n-4p any day except Wednesday

Office Aide – general clerical duties; receive messages, process mail, sort supplies

- Low vision department, flexible schedule available

Clinic Aide – Same Day/PACU area assist with replenishing stock, transport labs and medications, several shifts available

Ambassador – greet visitors and provide direction at the entrance of Mountains building or throughout, shifts available every day

Canteen Café/Store Aide – assist with replenishing stock, food prep (not cooking), position available weekdays during business hours

Hospitality Cart – visit and provide sundries to inpatients, position available any weekday except Wednesday in late morning or afternoon

Positions require a favorable background check, TB test, copy of fully COVID-19 vaccination card and seasonal flu vaccination.

*We appreciate **any amount** of time volunteers can give; one day a week, a few hours each day or several days a week.*

The following items and services have been identified by staff and patients as valuable additions to our commitment to providing comfort and recreation to hospitalized Veterans and to Veterans involved with the VA outpatient services.

Potential donors are asked to contact the Voluntary Service Office by calling 802-296-5190 (local) or 1-866-687-8387 ext. 5392 (toll free) to discuss donations. **Please call prior to making any donation to ensure the item is still needed.** We have limited space at the facility and cannot store excess items. Office hours are Monday through Friday, 8:00 AM - 4:00 PM.

Monetary donations

To support Veterans attending future local and National Veteran Games, donations may be accepted through the Veterans Education and Research Association of Northern New England (VERANNE). Donations will support costs such as, but not limited to; transportation, accommodations, registration and meals.

Several other accounts are available; please call Voluntary Service for details or for a specific account decided upon by the donor and Voluntary Service.

Example: #1023 Recreation Therapy – this account is designated for activities to help support local outings such as rock wall climbing, kayaking, snowshoeing, horse-back riding and activities for both inpatients and outpatients at the hospital and community clinics.

Example: #1024 Unrestricted for Veteran Needs - this account is used to purchase items for inpatients that are not supplied by appropriated funds. An example would be sweatpants, sweatshirts, t-shirts, toiletries etc.

Example: # 1061 VA Voluntary Service - this account is used to purchase items that enhance programs for our Veterans at the WRJ VAMC.

Comfort items: mens sweat pants and sweat shirts sizes Med – 3XL

Entertainment items: such as adult craft kits, activity books

Women's Center Support: unisex or boy baby items for new Mom gift bags

Homeless Veteran Support: department store and gas gift cards in low value increments such as \$20 each
