The General Orders information in this mailing is to be read at your Auxiliary meeting. Everything is also available on the Department website. We encourage you to check both the Department and the National websites often for information.

- 1. **COUNCIL OF ADMINISTRATION MEETING:** The next Council of Administration Meeting will be held at the Kingston Memorial Post #1088 on Saturday, October 28, 2023 at 1:00 p.m. sharp!
- 2. **STANDDOWN:** Standdown is scheduled for Friday, September 8th at the DoubleTree Hoel in Manchester.
- 3. **AUDITS:** A reminder that all Audit Reports completed and voted on for the 2nd Quarter (April, May, June) were to be received by the Department Treasurer no later than August 31st. If your Auxiliary or District is missing any Audits (list included with this email), please get them to the Department Treasurer right away.
- 4. **TRAINING:** Two training sessions have been scheduled as follows. Anyone is welcome to attend, *but* you need to contact the Department Secretary nhsecvfwaux@gmail.com to confirm you will be there, so we can plan how many we will have for lunch and how many handouts to prepare:
 - a. For <u>Auxiliary and District Secretaries</u>, <u>Treasurers and Trustees</u> on Saturday, September 9, 2023 at Franklin Post from 9 am to 2 pm with lunch also included. There will also be two attendance drawings of \$25 each.
 - b. For <u>Auxiliary and District Presidents</u> on Saturday, September 16, 2023 at Jaffrey Post from 9 am to 2 pm with lunch included. There will also be two attendance drawings of \$25 each.
- 5. WAYS & MEANS: The Department Ways & Means program needs your help. Please see and share the attached 3 pages of information with all of your members with regard to the Guarantee Program where the Auxiliary receives funds from the VFW program. All funds received are deposited to the Ways & Means program. We hope you will sign up to support the Department Ways & Means program. Thank you for your help.

- 6. **MEMBERSHIP:** A reminder to all Auxiliaries that the Department, District, and Auxiliary Officers (Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers) dues MUST be paid by December 31, or Department MUST submit a notification to National Headquarters by January 5 to relieve any non-paid officers from her/his duties. There are currently **14 officers** (Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers) at all levels in NH that are **not yet paid** for this 2023-2024 Auxiliary year. If you would like to know if your officers are on this list, please contact the Department Secretary for that information. Please get these officers paid just a soon as possible, so you don't need to rush at the last minute to get them in by December 31. It is important to get all members' dues paid, but this is a National requirement over which the Department has no control.
- 7. **BUDDY POPPY DISPLAY:** The theme for the Buddy Poppy Display Contest for the August 19th Council of Administration Meeting is "Wounded Warriors". Should you have any questions, please contact Colleen Pierce, Chairman (colleenpierce64@yahoo.com).
- 8. **POW-MIA CERRMONY:** The VFW has changed of the POW-MIA Ceremony at the NH Veterans Cemetery this year. This year's ceremony is scheduled for Saturday, September 23rd.
- 9. **EASTERN CONFERENCE:** The Eastern Conference Fall Meeting will be held in Atlantic City, NJ on October 20-22, 2023. Please see additional detailed information included with this mailing.
- 10. **DUES:** At the National Convention held in Phoenix in July, it was voted to increase the annual dues for <u>next year</u> (not this year) 2024-2025. Details will be provided through the Membership program.
