Recently I attended the VAVS quarterly meeting at the VA Medical Center and would like to share some updates that you can share with your Auxiliaries and share some options for your Auxiliary to consider and participate.....

> Volunteers have been welcomed back into the Community Living Center "CLC" with the following guidelines:

- If you are closer than Six feet to a Veteran, you must wear a mask.
- If you go on the "CLC" more than two times to assist, sponsor, or participate with an event, you must go through the process of becoming a "Registered Volunteer".
- If you would like to sponsor any event (i.e. Bingo, Ice Cream Social etc) you have to go through Recreation Therapy to ensure organization and tracking.
- Bingo is now held every Thursday 6 7 PM. Currently the Elks are committed to doing Bingo on the 3rd Thursday of the month. The CLC Recreation Dept is hoping that additional VSO (Veteran Service Organizations) will also "volunteer" to sponsor Bingo for the CLC Veterans. Please "note "BINGO BUCKS has now increased to \$40.00 in Bingo Bucks.
- CLC Veterans are now able to go out to organizations for various events. Recreation Therapy has asked that each VSO let them know in advance of any events they would like the CLC residents to attend.
