- 1. DEADLINE PATRIOTS PEN & VOICE OF DEMOCRACY: The deadline for submitting your entries for Patriots Pen and Voice of Democracy is that they need to be in the hands of your District VFW Commander *no later than November 15, 2023*. Please contact Scholarship Chairman Tracy Kelley with any questions.
- 2. **COUNCIL OF ADMINISTRATION MEETING:** The next Council of Administration Meeting will be held at Southern New Hampshire University on River Road in Manchester, NH on Saturday, January 20, 2024 at 10:00 a.m. sharp! More specific direction will be forthcoming.
- 3. **SCHOLASTIC BANQUET:** The Annual Scholastic Banquet is scheduled for Saturday, January 20, 2024. The meet and greet will be at 2 p.m. and the Banquet is scheduled for 3 p.m. at Southern New Hampshire University on River Road in Manchester, NH. Specific details will be available shortly.
- 4. **SCHOLARSHIPS:** If you would like to donate to the Scholarship programs, it would be a great time to do so now, as the Scholastic Banquet will be held on Saturday, January 20, 2024. - 8. **AUDITS:** A reminder that the third quarter Audit covering the period of July, August and September 2023 is due to be completed by October 31, 2023, and to be accepted by the Auxiliary and sent to the Department Treasurer to be received by her no later than November 30, 2023. <u>NOTE</u>: There are 4 Auxiliaries and 1 District currently missing Audits for the 2nd Quarter (April, May & June, 2023) or earlier, so please if you are one of these Auxiliaries, complete your Audits, have them accepted by your Auxiliary and send them to the Department Treasurer ASAP, as they are now late.
- 9. MEMBERSHIP: A reminder to all Auxiliaries that the Department, District, and Auxiliary Officers (Presidents, Secretaries and Treasurers) dues MUST be paid by December 31, or Department *MUST* submit a notification to National Headquarters by January 5 to relieve any non-paid officers from her/his duties. There are currently **11 officers** (Presidents, Secretaries and/or Treasurers) at all levels in NH that are **not yet paid** for this 2023-2024 Auxiliary year. Please contact the Department Secretary to determine if your officers are on this list and please get these officers' dues paid just a soon as possible, so they don't need to be removed from office, per the rules of National. This is a National mandate over which the Department has no control.
