- 5. DISTRICT DELEGATES: March is the month for electing District Delegates & Alternates. Please be sure to include this election in your March meeting. To count in the membership, the members' dues must be paid and be in good standing. There is one Delegate and one Alternate for every 15 paid members of the Auxiliary on the date of the election. A form is enclosed for you to complete and send to your District Secretary. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact President Kim Copson or Secretary Linda Meader who will be able to assist you.
- 6. YOUNG AMERICAN PATRIOTIC ART PROGRAM: Donations are currently being accepted. Please note that this Program now consists of two separate categories, i.e., 2-dimensional and 3dimensional, for which we give awards. So, if your Auxiliary would like to donate to this program, please send your checks, payable to VFW Auxiliary, Dept. of NH, to the Department Treasurer Carol Harvey and be sure to note the reason for the donation in the memo section of your check!! If you have entries, please review the promotion information included with these General Orders for the deadlines and to make plans to get the submissions to the Department Chairman Tracy Kelley.
- 7. NEW REPORTING SYSTEM: The new reporting system is up and running. To access the site, go to vfwauxnh.org; on far right click on LOGIN; next screen click "Member Only". Enter your Member ID # and the password is your last name with capitalized first letter (you can change your password when you get in). Next screen on the left you will see a list of items in red. Click on the Program Reporting. This will take you to the reporting section and just follow directions from there. Should you have any questions about maneuvering or entering information in the site, please contact Tracy Kelley tracyk372@yahoo.com or Trish St. Germain trishvfw@gmail.com directly for assistance. The non-reporting sections are being updated, so you may find either no information available as yet or information that does not pertain to New Hampshire. Tracy and Trish are working on this to get this portion up and running as soon as possible. We appreciate your patience.
- 8. AUDITS: A reminder that the third quarter Audit covering the period of October, November and December 2023 was due to be completed by January 31, 2024, to be accepted by the Auxiliary and sent to the Department Treasurer to be received by her no later than February 29, 2024. <u>NOTE</u>: There are 2 Auxiliaries and 1 District currently missing the Audit for the 3rd Quarter Audits (July, August & September 2023) and 16 Auxiliaries and 3 Districts who are missing the 4th Quarter Audits (October, November & December 2023), so please if you are one of these Auxiliaries or Districts, complete your Audits, have them accepted by your Auxiliary and send them to the Department Treasurer ASAP, as they are now late. You can check the list in these General Orders prepared by the Department Treasurer to see if you are on this list.
- 9. MEMBERSHIP: Thank you to all who helped bring the Department to 94.14% in membership as of midnight February 27th. Our Membership Chairman has an ongoing award available. The award is your Auxiliary has a chance in a drawing for \$500 for attaining or converting a minimum of 10 new life or annual conversion to life memberships, covering the period of July 1, 2023 through May 31, 2024 (to be confirmed on the MALTA June 1, 2024 Report). So please encourage your members who are not life members to look into converting to life membership. If they do, they will never have to pay dues again.

- 11. **DECEASED MEMBERS:** Each year our members who have passed away this year are included in the Memorial Service Program at the Annual Department Convention. In order to include their names, you need to notify the Department Chaplain Buddy Nicholas so he can compile the list. There is a form included with these General Orders to complete and send to Buddy by email (<u>nnicholas1299@gmail.com</u>) or by U.S. Mail (PO Box 534 W. Ossipee, NH 03890). Buddy would also like to remind you that any deceased member during this year is to be reported to National <u>after July 1, 2024</u>.
- 12. NATIONAL REQUIREMENT: Because the main reason for our organization is to help our veterans, National requires that "All Auxiliaries MUST complete at least one project, activity or donation that benefits veterans by April 30, 2024. If not, the Department MUST submit a request for a suspension of an Auxiliary by that date." As of this writing, there are five (5) Auxiliaries who are not yet listed on the monthly donation report form from the Department Treasurer as having made any donations. If your Auxiliary hasn't yet donated to a project or conducted an activity that benefits the veterans, please vote at your next Auxiliary meeting to do so and then please send your Auxiliary check for any donation in any amount to the Department Treasurer Carol Harvey at 18 Sylvan Way, Wells, ME 04090 as soon as possible. This way your Auxiliary will be able to check off that requirement now. Those Auxiliaries who are not yet reported are Claremont, Hinsdale, Raymond and Somersworth. Thank you very much.
- 13. UPCOMING CHANGE IN DUES: A reminder that at the amount of dues to the National organization will change from \$5 to \$10 beginning July 1, 2024, which makes the amount of each dues payment to be sent to our Department Treasurer \$16. Keeping this in mind, if your Auxiliary determines it needs to increase the amount of dues paid by each annual member all you need to do is to make a motion at your regular Auxiliary Meeting which needs to pass by a majority vote of the members present at that meeting. If you do increase the amount of dues for each annual member to pay, it would be a good idea to notify all those members of the upcoming increase in the annual dues that will begin on July 1, 2024, in order to ward off any confusion.
